Josiah Hoskinson was born 1759 Maryland. He died in 1836 and is buried in an abandoned cemetery on farm now owned by J. A. Amos in Jackson Township. He was married his first wife unknown. Children: Thomas; Charles; John; James; Kathryn; Enos. Second wife was Alcy Brent. Children: Josiah; Elisha; Elizabeth; Hugh; Sarah; Isabel married a Quick. Source Page 374, Roster of Soldiers and Patriots of the American Revolution Buried in Indiana, 1938.

At the time that Vera Eliz Hoskins (b.1922-d.1989) joined the DAR, reference was made to this same book.

A more recent listing made by Ruth Pruitt and given to Ruth Hutchison on 12 July 1976, and published in Shelby County Cemetery Records shows a " FROST HILL CEMETERY - AMOS FARM

 Notes by Hugh Thomas Hoskins (b.1936)-

My great-great-grandfather, Josiah Hoskinson, was born in 1759 in Virginia. He served in the US.Revolutionary War in a company known as George Washington's Bodyguards.

He is NOT to be confused with others of the same name who variously died in Ohio and/or were paupers or in an asylum of any sort.

"Our" Josiah married Isabell Evans in 1795 in what is now Monongalia, West Virginia. They had 6 children, and migrated to central Kentucky. She died in Floyd Co., Ky in 1814.

There is a very small town named Hoskinston in eastern Ky. near the No.Carolina border. NO connection has ever been made with it.

Josiah was again married in 1815 in Washington Co., Ky., to Alcy Brent, the widow of Jacob Cutsinger (with whom she had had 3 children); Josiah and Alcy had 6 children -- the second of whom was my great-grandfather, Hugh Abel Hoskinson.

They moved in the Washington, Nelson, Hardin Counties area of Ky. and eventually settled in the Edinburgh, Indiana, area where Josiah died in 1836. He was buried in a small private cemetery on the J.A.Amos farm; in the last half of the 1900s the gravestones were moved about 30 feet to the south to build a house. Some are readable; some have been vandalized; Josiah's is not obvious, but it was noted in an earlier published reading of the stones.

Hugh Abel Hoskinson, was born in 1824 in Ky. In time he shortened his name to Hoskins. As far as we know, none of his siblings did the same. He died in the area of Edinburg, Indiana, and is buried in what at this time is the St.George Luthern Churchyard east of Edinburg.

Hugh Abel Hoskins and his wife Elizabeth Snepp had 12 children; the family name was carried by blood only thru his sons John (known very affectionately to my dad as "Uncle John" and David Julius Hoskins, my grandfather. Another son, Josiah (known as Joe) adopted a boy whom he named William or Billy who was last seen by the family to have passed thru Columbus, In., in the 1980s. David had only one son, Hugh Adam Hoskins; he had only one son, Hugh Thomas Hoskins; he had only one son, Hugh Douglas Hoskins (b.1971). John had 12 children: 7 boys and 5 girls. The only other Hoskins male at my generation level is Fred John Hoskins, Jr., (b.1938) and he has one son, David Lee Hoskins (b.1969). To David and Doug we are dependent to continue the family name.

There is a Bible which belonged to John's son Grover which was passed to his son James and thence to his daughter Sharon. Have not yet seen or confirmed the contents; it may have belonged to John; not sure yet.

The general consensus is that the name Hoskins originated as Roger, which morphed to Rodge, Hodge, and on to Hodgkins, and Hoskins, and Hoskinson (with the Haskins and Huskins somewhat related, too) -- likely mostly in England (or the British Isles, anyway) -- before coming to the Western Hemisphere where it was again shortened to Hoskins. There are still a swarm of them in Floyd, Washington, Nelson, and Hardin Counties area of KY; some of which are likely more closely related than others, but we have NO firm connection.

Notes for Sarah J. Hoskins:

There have been known to be records stating Sarah's birth as 31 July 1851; which is NOT correct. She was a twin to John - both born 31 July 1857.

Notes for John Snapp Hoskins:

Death date discrep 23 Mar /vs/ 23 May

As per Johnson Co Votal Records: 23 Mar'36; just 6 days before Hugh T. Hoskins was born.

There has been some discrepancy as tho John's middle name being Schnep or Snapp; the latter is more prevalent and was his mother's maiden name.

Hattie/Nettie ran off with another/younger man --- poss. travelling salesman. John later lived with Virgil and then with Grover. Mid.name may be Snapp after his mom.

There have been known to be records stating Sarah's birth as 31 July 1851; which is NOT correct. She was a twin to John - both born 31 July 1857.

Notes for Alcy Hoskins:

This person is variously known as Alcy or Elsie; but the Bible records of Hugh Abel Hoskins(on) (handed thru Grover, James, and Sharon) states Alcy; this was likely after Hugh's mom - Alcy nee Brent.

Notes for Alice Mary Hoskins:

There have been known to be records stating a birth on a Mary Hoskins in 1860; that is incorrect; her name was Alice Mary Hoskins.

This person is variously known as Alice or Allice; even so in the Bible records of Hugh Abel Hoskins(on) (handed thru Grover, James, and Sharon). The entry here is the more-common Alice.

Notes for Ida Hoskins:

Ida is buried in the old far S.W. corner of the cemetery.

Ida was unknown until her grave was discovered during a 1993 visit to the ceme.

Notes for David Julius Hoskins:

Harriet's nickname was Hattie. Common family usage birth was 27Mar1872 SLC#292703 notes that Harriet E. b.28Mar1870 Porter Twmsp report by C.W.Reed USC 1880 Ohio notes age=9 implying 1871

MarrCert in poss H.T.Hoskins:: St.Pauls German Protestant Church Cinci Harriet's birth year on tombstone is 1872.

After their marriage they stayed in Cincinnati for a while, moved to Chicago where their son Hugh Adam was born, then to St.Louis, and later back to Cincinnati.

There is an envelope to David Julius Hoskins from the furniture factory of his brother William Hoskins in Aurora, Indiana.

As David was a factory-rep/salesman, it likely contained photos of furniture for him to use in his calls on local stores.

The address of 2146 Cleney in Norwood (an part of Cincinnati) is not too far from the 3305 Woodburn address where the Ben Weinberg family lived.

Ben's wife, Clara (nee Amberg) was a sister to David's wife Harriet "Hattie" Amberg.

David met Hattie while he was a pharmacy clerk near the Weinbergs while she was visiting her sister.

The timing of the envelope and address is UNKNOWN.

Possibly it was before they left Cincinnati for Chicago, or maybe after they returned to Cincinnati from St.Louis.

Notes for Josiah H. Hoskins:

Name originally Josiah per USC 1900 Ill.Cook. Always known as "Jo/Joe"; thought to be Joseph. Obit says Josiah.

Cemetery records indicate Joseph H.; t-stone says "JOE" w/ no dates.

Lived at 425 Manchester, Aurora.

Foreman in his bro's chair co.

Notes for William Lewis Hoskins:

William is listed as Adolphus in the 1870 USC; obit=midname=Lewis, other=Loren. Per obit his grandfather Josiah served as a Sgt.Major under Capt. Thomas Beale and Col. Moses Rawlings; moved to Ky in 1832.

Will was a member of Yeatman#162 in Cincy.

The cemetery card indicates b.19Apr1871, but the stone says 1870; obit=19Apr'70 Lived at 220 4th St, Aurora; owned the Indianapolis Chair Co. in Aurora
