Hardin County, Ky Tax Records

An abstract for some Hoskins(on) & related families.

There follows ...

- .- a 2-page letter of transmittal with some extra notations
- .- an 11-page extract of entries relative to David Hoskinson, et.seq.

Data has been transcribed from --Hardin County, Ky., Tax Assessor's Lists, reels 8013(#90) through 8016(#93). Encl. is the updated "David Hoskinson on Hardin Co. Tax Lists" (as of date: 30 Jun 2013), including the abstracted info from the 1844-1860 tax lists. Shred all earlier (i.e., less complete) versions of this compilation. These lists help track the several Hoskins/Hoskinson families.

The Hartly and Harned entries are to track related families my Hoskinsons married into. In commenting on the "stray" Hoskins names, I will differentiate between speculation and fact.

1810 & 1811 – Ezekiel Hoskins: not known.

1812-1815 – James Hoskins: probably the same as James C. Hoskins on 1816-1817 lists; James has land and is in McGaughey's Co. (cp. 1817). Otherwise, not known. 1814 – Jacob Hoskins: not known. He is not William Hoskinson's son, Jacob, b. ca. 1830.

1824 – Charles Hoskins >21 has 100 acres Breckinridge Co. land; probably the Rev war vet on 1813-1817 Breckinridge Co. tax lists with same acreage. This is not David Hoskinson's son, Charles, who appears on 1827 Hardin Co. list.

1829 & 1830 – Hugh Hoskins: not known. One Hugh Hoskins >21 appears on 1811 Breckinridge Co. tax list; also 1814-1817, 1819-1823, 1825, 1827, 1833-34.

1834 – Wesley J. Hoskins: may be a son of David Hoskinson. The censuses show David with one son same approximate age who likely d. early; he's not among David's named heirs in the 1855 land settlement deed. Wesley Hoskins wit in 1837 a deed by David's son, Charles.

1834 – William Hoskins: likely is David Hoskinson's son, who didn't purchase land until 1836.
1836 – John W. Hoskinson: perhaps the same as Wesley J. Hoskins. Wesley is possibly a middle name. When the middle name is sometimes used in place of the given, the first name then typically becomes the middle initial. William Hoskinson's second son John Wesley Hoskinson (b. 1836) was sometimes called by his middle name=a different individual.

1836 – Elizabeth Hoskinson, 2 horses \$60: not known. Elizabeth Hoskins appears on 1838 Breckinridge Co. tax list, with 1 horse \$40. David Hoskinson's daughter Elizabeth (b. ca. 1822) is too young to be this individual.

1840 – John H. Hoskins: not known. John Hoskins: not known.

1840 – S. B. Hoskins: almost certainly is Robert Hoskins' son. Scarlet B. Hoskins appears with Robert Hoskins on 1828-1829, 1831 Breckinridge Co. tax lists.

1841 – Vincent Hodskin: head of a Catholic family located over near E-town area. Some time later he removed to Daviess Co. and is buried in a Catholic cemetery there.

1841 – Peter C. Hoskinson & David Hoskinson Jr. are sons of David Hoskinson. Named in 1855 land settlement deed.

1843 – George Hoskins and Davis Hoskins, both >21: not known.

1844 – George Hoskins, minor, and W. D. Hoskins >21. George may be the same individual on 1843; age was possibly mis-entered. He has 2 horses, higher value in 1844.

W. D. Hoskins may be Davis Hoskins of 1843 entry. Each has 1 horse worth \$30. William D. Hoskins m. Rachel A. Dillard 25 Dec 1842 in Hardin Co. by Colmore Lovelace, Bap Min. [Bk. B-111] Are these 2 the same? See also 1845.

1846 – Benj Hoskins & Jonathan Hoskins, both minors: almost certainly are sons of Robert Hoskins. Benjamin Hoskins witnessed Robert's 1848 deed of sale to Jonathan Hoskins. [Bk. X-80]

1849 – Burkly Hoskins: seems to be the same person as S. B. or Scarlet B. Hoskins, whose maternal grandfather was Scarlet Berkley.

1855 ff – David Hoskinson is almost certainly son of David Hoskinson. Named in 1855 land settlement deed.

1857 – James Hoskins: may be a younger person than the James of 1810 decade. One James Hoskins m. Rose Ella Spink 16 Jul 1857 in Hardin Co. by an RCP. Thos Spink proved age of both. [Bk. C-106] This may be James Randall Hoskins, age 79, parents unk, d. 6 Sep 1913 of senility in Louisville at Little Sisters of the Poor; W. Kennedy of E-town, informant; body removed to Colesburg. [KY death certif.] May be James Randel Hodskins, son of Vincent & Elizabeth Hodskins, bap 9 Jul 1837, in Catholic Church in Colesburg.

1857 – John Hoskins with 1 child between 6 & 18, might be the John Hoskinson, age 25, who m. Catherine A. Brewer 26 Apr 1847 in Hardin Co. by an RCP. [Bk. B-155]

1857 – Alfred Hoskins: almost certainly is son of Robert Hoskins. Alfred, Harrison, & S. B. Hoskins were surety for the 1839 mortgage Robert Hoskins signed to Jacob Hartley. [Bk. S-143] Alfred appears on 1833-1835, 1839, 1850, 1852-1856, 1860 Breckinridge Co. tax lists.

1859 - Clerk's error added "-son" to Robert, S. B. & Alfred Hoskins' last names.

1860 – James M. Hoskinson, minor, is son of William Hoskinson.

I was delighted to learn that William Hoskinson was the admr. for David Hoskinson's estate. Researching this further. As you can see, Rev war vet Charles Hoskinson is not on Breckinridge or Hardin Co. tax lists after 1839, and David's son, Charles Jr., is on the 1827 Hardin Co. tax list only. (Where did that rascal go? ⁽³⁾)
